BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 19.28.371 and 1981 c 57 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows: 6 ((Any device used or useful in the diagnosis or treatment of
- 7 <u>disease or injury</u>)) (1) A medical device which is not in violation of
- 8 the Medical Device Amendments of 1976, Public Law No. 94-295, 90 Stat.
- 9 539, as amended from time to time, and as interpreted by the Food and
- 10 Drug Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human
- 11 Services or its successor, shall be deemed to be in compliance with all
- 12 requirements imposed by this chapter.
- 13 (2) The installation, maintenance, or repair of a medical device
- 14 <u>deemed in compliance with this chapter is exempt from licensing</u>

- 17 19.28.101. This exemption does not include work providing electrical
