1 AN ACT Relating to providing confidentiality to certain insurance 2 commissioner examinations; and amending RCW 48.02.065.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 48.02.065 and 2001 c 57 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) Documents, materials, or other information as described in 6 7 subsection (5) of this section are confidential by law and privileged, 8 are not subject to public disclosure under chapter 42.17 RCW, and are not subject to subpoena directed to the commissioner or any person who 9 10 received documents, materials, or other information while acting under the authority of the commissioner. The commissioner is authorized to 11 12 use such documents, materials, or other information in the furtherance any regulatory or legal action brought as a part of the 13 of 14 commissioner's official duties. The confidentiality and privilege 15 created by this section and RCW 42.17.31916 applies only to the 16 commissioner, any person acting under the authority of the commissioner, the national association of insurance commissioners and 17 its affiliates and subsidiaries, regulatory and law enforcement 18

1 officials of other states and nations, the federal government, and 2 international authorities.

3 (2) Neither the commissioner nor any person who received documents, 4 materials, or other information while acting under the authority of the 5 commissioner is permitted or required to testify in any private civil 6 action concerning any confidential and privileged documents, materials, 7 or information subject to subsection (1) of this section.

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(3) The commissioner:

(a) May share documents, materials, or other information, including 9 the confidential and privileged documents, materials, or information 10 subject to subsection (1) of this section, with (i) the national 11 association of insurance commissioners and its affiliates and 12 subsidiaries, and (ii) regulatory and law enforcement officials of 13 other states and nations, the federal government, and international 14 authorities, if the recipient agrees to maintain the confidentiality 15 and privileged status of the document, material, or other information; 16

17 (b) May receive documents, materials, or information, including otherwise either confidential or privileged, or both, documents, 18 materials, or information, from (i) the national association of 19 insurance commissioners and its affiliates and subsidiaries, and (ii) 20 regulatory and law enforcement officials of other states and nations, 21 22 the federal government, and international authorities and shall maintain as confidential and privileged any document, material, or 23 24 information received that is either confidential or privileged, or 25 both, under the laws of the jurisdiction that is the source of the document, material, or information; and 26

(c) May enter into agreements governing the sharing and use ofinformation consistent with this subsection.

(4) No waiver of an existing privilege or claim of confidentiality in the documents, materials, or information may occur as a result of disclosure to the commissioner under this section or as a result of sharing as authorized in subsection (3) of this section.

(5)(a) Documents, materials, or information, which is either confidential or privileged, or both, which has been provided to the commissioner by (((a))) (i) the national association of insurance commissioners and its affiliates and subsidiaries, (((b))) (ii) regulatory or law enforcement officials of other states and nations, the federal government, or international authorities, or (((c))) (iii) agencies of this state, is confidential and privileged only if the documents, materials, or information is protected from disclosure by the applicable laws of the jurisdiction that is the source of the document, material, or information.

5 (b) Working papers, documents, materials, or information produced

6 by, obtained by, or disclosed to the commissioner or any other person

7 in the course of a financial or market conduct examination are not

8 required to be disclosed by the commissioner unless cited by the

9 <u>commissioner in connection with an agency action.</u> A waiver of existing

10 privilege or claim of confidentiality may not occur as a result of a

11 <u>disclosure to the commissioner under this section.</u>

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
