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## SENATE BILL 5482

State of Washington 58th Legislature 2003 Regular Session

- AN ACT Relating to establishing the Washington state economic development commission to replace the governor's small business improvement council; adding a new section to chapter 43.175 RCW; and
- 4 repealing RCW 43.175.010, 43.175.020, and 43.175.901.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.175 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) The Washington state economic development commission is established to oversee and direct the economic development strategies and policies of the department of community, trade, and economic development.
- 12 (2) The Washington state economic development commission shall consist of nine members appointed by the governor, with the advice and 13 In making appointments, the governor shall 14 consent of the senate. 15 consult with organizations that have an interest in economic development, including, but not limited to, economic development 16 17 councils, chambers of commerce, port associations, industry associations, labor organizations, minority business associations, and 18 19 the chairs of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over

The members serve at the pleasure of the governor for six-year terms. 3 initial members, three must be appointed for two-year terms, three must 4 5 be appointed for four-year terms, and the remainder must be appointed for six-year terms. Thereafter, members must be appointed for six-year 6

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- and northern Puget Sound and reflect the state's various business 9 10 Members of the commission shall serve statewide interests
- while preserving their diverse perspectives, and shall be recognized 11
- leaders in their fields with demonstrated experience in disciplines 12
- 13 related to economic development. At least seven members must be
- 14 selected from private businesses within Washington state.

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- (3) The Washington state economic development commission shall 15 16 perform the following duties:
  - (a) Review and periodically update the state's economic development strategy and performance measures, and perform an annual evaluation of the strategy;
  - (b) Provide policy direction to the department of community, trade, and economic development;
  - (c) Assist the department of community, trade, and economic development with the procurement and deployment of private funds for business development, recruitment, and promotion; and
  - (d) Provide planning and strategic and programmatic direction to the department of community, trade, and economic development, with specific emphasis on the following:
  - (i) Development of strategies that promote business retention, expansion, and creation within the state;
- (ii) Development of marketing strategies for the global marketplace 30 31 that promote products and services of the state; and
  - (iii) Development of strategies to enhance relationships and cooperation between local governments, economic development councils, state agencies, and the legislature.
- (4) Members of the Washington state economic development commission 35 shall be reimbursed for travel expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 36 37 and 43.03.060 and are considered a class three group for purposes of 38 compensation under RCW 43.03.240.

SB 5482 p. 2 (5) Staffing for the Washington state economic development commission shall be provided by the department of community, trade, and economic development or other state agencies as appropriate, and within existing resources and operations.

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- (6) Creation of the Washington state economic development commission shall not be construed to modify any authority or budgetary responsibility of the governor or the department of community, trade, and economic development.
