- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.155 and 2001 c 41 s 14 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Before issuing an original license or identification card or
- 7 renewing a license or identification card under this chapter, the
- 8 licensing agent shall determine if the applicant wants to register to
- 9 vote or transfer his or her voter registration by asking the following
- 10 questions:
- 11 <u>First:</u> "Do you want to register to vote or transfer your voter
- 12 registration?"
- 13 If the applicant chooses to register or transfer a registration,
- 14 the agent shall ((state)) ask the following:
- 15 (("I would like to remind you that you must be)) Second: "Are you
- 16 a United States citizen and at least eighteen years of age ((in order
- 17 to vote.))?"

If the applicant responds in the affirmative the agent shall then provide the applicant with a voter registration form and instructions and shall record that the applicant has requested to register to vote or transfer a voter registration.
