- 1 AN ACT Relating to privacy requirements for telecommunications
- 2 companies; adding a new section to chapter 80.36 RCW; and creating a
- 3 new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that telephone
- 6 customers have a strong privacy interest in their calling information,
- 7 including who they call, who has called them, and how often they call
- 8 specific telephone numbers. The legislature further finds that such
- 9 information should not be disclosed by a telecommunications company
- 10 without the express permission of the customer.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 80.36 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Except as required by law or with the express approval of the
- 14 customer, a telecommunications company that receives or obtains
- 15 customer proprietary network information by virtue of its provision of
- 16 a telecommunications service shall only use, disclose, or permit access
- 17 to individually identifiable customer proprietary network information
- 18 in its provision of: (1) The telecommunications service from which

- 1 such information is derived; or (2) services necessary to, or used in,
- 2 the provision of such telecommunications service, including the
- 3 publishing of directories.
