- 1 AN ACT Relating to the disruption of traffic by pedestrians;
- 2 amending RCW 46.63.020; adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW; and
- 3 prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A pedestrian may not intentionally impede, or otherwise 8 disrupt, the flow of traffic on a highway that has been designated, in 9 whole or in part, as a highway of statewide significance.
- 10 (2) A violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor punishable under RCW 9A.20.021.
- 12 (3) Nothing in this section prohibits the filing, at any time, of 13 a cause of action for damages resulting from the disruption of traffic 14 caused by a pedestrian or pedestrians.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.63.020 and 2001 c 325 s 4 are each amended to read 16 as follows:
- Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or
