1 AN ACT Relating to the disruption of traffic by pedestrians; 2 amending RCW 46.63.020; adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW; and 3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:

(1) Pedestrians may not intentionally impede, or otherwise disrupt,
the flow of traffic on a highway that has been designated, in whole or
in part, as a highway of statewide significance.

10 (2) A violation of this section is a class C felony punishable 11 under RCW 9A.20.021.

12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.63.020 and 2001 c 325 s 4 are each amended to read 13 as follows:

Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution relating to traffic including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is designated as a traffic infraction and may not be classified as a
