- 1 AN ACT Relating to correcting a technical error to clarify that the
- 2 family law handbook shall be provided when a person applies for a
- 3 marriage license; and amending RCW 2.56.180.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.56.180 and 2002 c 49 s 3 are each amended to read as 6 follows:
  - (1) The administrator for the courts will create a handbook explaining the sections of Washington law pertaining to the rights and responsibilities of marital partners to each other and to any children during a marriage and a dissolution of marriage. The handbook may also be provided in videotape or other electronic form.
- 12 (2) The handbook created under subsection (1) of this section will 13 be provided by the county auditor when an individual ((files a marriage 14 certificate under RCW 26.04.090)) applies for a marriage license under 15 RCW 26.04.140.
- 16 (3) The information contained in the handbook created under subsection (1) of this section will be reviewed and updated annually.
- 18 The handbook must contain the following information:

- 1 (a) Information on prenuptial agreements as contracts and as a 2 means of structuring financial arrangements and other aspects of the 3 marital relationship;
  - (b) Information on shared parental responsibility for children, including establishing a residential schedule for the child in the event of the dissolution of the marriage;
- 7 (c) Information on notice requirements and standards for parental 8 relocation;
  - (d) Information on child support for minor children;
- 10 (e) Information on property rights, including equitable 11 distribution of assets and premarital and postmarital property rights;
- 12 (f) Information on spousal maintenance;

- 13 (g) Information on domestic violence, child abuse, and neglect, including penalties;
  - (h) Information on the court process for dissolution;
  - (i) Information on the effects of dissolution on children;
- 17 (j) Information on community resources that are available to 18 separating or divorcing persons and their children.
