- 2 amending RCW 46.61.608; and adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW.

- MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 "Ultranarrow vehicle" means a vehicle having a maximum width of
- 7 forty-two inches from mirror to mirror.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.61.608 and 1975 c 62 s 46 are each amended to read 9 as follows:
- 10 (1) All motorcycles <u>and ultranarrow vehicles</u> are entitled to full
- 11 use of a lane and no motor vehicle shall be driven in such a manner as
- 12 to deprive any motorcycle <u>or ultranarrow vehicle</u> of the full use of a
- 13 lane. This subsection shall not apply to motorcycles <u>or ultranarrow</u>
- 14 <u>vehicles</u> operated two abreast in a single lane, <u>under subsection (4) of</u>
- 15 this section.
- 16 (2) The operator of a motorcycle <u>or ultranarrow vehicle</u> shall not
- 17 overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by the vehicle being
- 18 overtaken.

(3) No person shall operate a motorcycle <u>or ultranarrow vehicle</u> between lanes of traffic or between adjacent lines or rows of vehicles.

- (4) Motorcycles ((shall not)) and ultranarrow vehicles may be operated ((more than)) up to two abreast in a single lane.
- (5) Subsections (2) and (3) of this section shall not apply to police officers in the performance of their official duties.
