1 AN ACT Relating to personal use trailer license fees; amending RCW
2 46.16.0621; and adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.16.0621 and 2002 c 352 s 7 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) License tab fees shall be thirty dollars per year for all
7 vehicles.

8 (2) For the purposes of this section, "license tab fees" are
9 defined as the general fees paid annually for licensing motor vehicles
10 and trailers as defined in RCW 46.04.620 and 46.04.623. ((Trailers
11 licensed under RCW 46.16.068 or 46.16.085 and)) Campers licensed under
12 RCW 46.16.505 are not required to pay license tab fees under this
13 section.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 (1) Private passenger car one or two-wheel trailers of two thousand
17 pounds gross weight or less, may be licensed upon the payment of a
18 license fee in the sum of four dollars and fifty cents or, if the

1 vehicle was previously licensed in this state and has not been
2 registered in another jurisdiction in the intervening period, a renewal
3 license fee in the sum of three dollars and twenty-five cents, but only
4 if such trailers are to be operated upon the public highway by the
5 owners thereof.

6 (2) Private use trailers over two thousand pounds gross weight
7 operated upon a public highway by the owner of the trailer may be
8 licensed upon the payment of a license fee of twenty-seven dollars, or
9 if the trailer was previously licensed in this state and has not been
10 registered in another jurisdiction in the intervening period, a renewal
11 fee of twenty-three dollars and seventy-five cents.

12 (3) It is the intention of the legislature that the reduced license
13 fee under this section applies only to trailers operated for personal
14 use of the owners and not trailers held for rental to the public.
