- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.44 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, or the state of Washington, its political subdivisions, or municipal corporations to require, directly or indirectly, that any employee or prospective employee submit genetic information or submit to screening for genetic information as a condition of employment or continued
- 12 "Genetic information" for purposes of this chapter, is information
- about inherited characteristics that can be derived from a DNA-based or other laboratory test, family history, or medical examination.
- 15 "Genetic information" for purposes of this chapter, does not include:
- 16 (1) Routine physical measurements, including chemical, blood, and urine
- 17 analysis, unless conducted purposefully to diagnose genetic or

- 1 inherited characteristics; and (2) results from tests for abuse of
- 2 alcohol or drugs, or for the presence of HIV.
