- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.06 RCW 4 5 to read as follows:
- When requested by the governor or the director of the department of 6 7 personnel, nonconviction criminal history fingerprint record checks
- 8 shall be conducted through the Washington state patrol identification
- 9 and criminal history section and the federal bureau of investigation on
- 10 applicants for agency head positions appointed by the governor.
- Information received pursuant to this section shall be confidential and 11
- 12 made available only to the governor or director of the department of
- personnel or their employees directly involved in the selection, 13
- hiring, or background investigation of the subject of the record check. 14
- When necessary, applicants may be employed on a conditional basis pending completion of the criminal history record check. "Agency head" 16
- 17 as used in this section has the same definition as provided in RCW
