- AN ACT Relating to payments to jurors; and amending RCW 2.36.150. 1
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. RCW 2.36.150 and 1987 c 202 s 105 are each amended to read 3 4 as follows:
- 5 Jurors shall receive for each day's attendance, besides mileage at the rate determined under RCW 43.03.060, the following ((compensation)) 6 7 expense payments:
- 8 (1) Grand jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no case less than ten dollars; 9
- 10 (2) Petit jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no 11 case less than ten dollars;
- 12 (3) Coroner's jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no case less than ten dollars; 13
- 14 (4) District court jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no case less than ten dollars: 15
- PROVIDED, That a person excused from jury service at his or her own 16
- 17 request shall be allowed not more than a per diem and such mileage, if
- any, as to the court shall seem just and equitable under all 18
- 19 circumstances: PROVIDED FURTHER, That the state shall fully reimburse

- 1 the county in which trial is held for all jury fees and witness fees
- 2 related to criminal cases which result from incidents occurring within
- 3 an adult or juvenile correctional institution: PROVIDED FURTHER, That
- 4 the compensation paid jurors shall be determined by the county
- 5 legislative authority and shall be uniformly applied within the county.
