4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.210 6 RCW to read as follows:

- (1) A kindergarten through grade twelve public or private school administrator, teacher, or school employee, unless they are a qualified medical professional, may not recommend to a parent or legal guardian of a student that the student seek a prescription for a medication that is prescribed with the intent of affecting or altering the thought processes, mood, or behavior of the student.
 - (2) Nothing in this section:
- (a) Prohibits a kindergarten through grade twelve public or private school administrator, teacher, counselor, or nurse from communicating with a parent or legal guardian of a student concerning the behavior of the student at school; or
