AN ACT Relating to school policies on health evaluations for and the administration of psychotropic drugs to children; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.210 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.210 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 Each board of directors of a public school district and each 8 governing board of a private school or, if none, the chief administrator of the private school shall adopt and implement a policy 9 10 that (1) prohibits any school personnel from recommending the use of psychotropic drugs for any child and (2) requires school personnel to 11 12 send a letter to a parent or legal guardian recommending that an 13 appropriate medical or behavioral health evaluation be conducted by a licensed physician if school personnel perceive that a child may have 14 15 a behavioral or psychological problem.
