- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.62.260 and 1994 c 250 s 6 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- No person shall operate a transient accommodation as defined in this chapter without having a valid license issued by the department.
- 8 Applications for a transient accommodation license shall be filed with
- 9 the department sixty days or more before initiating business as a
- 10 transient accommodation. All licenses issued under the provisions of
- 11 this chapter shall expire one year from the effective date. All
- 12 applications for renewal of licenses shall be ((made thirty days or
- 13 more prior to the date of expiration of the license)) postmarked no
- 14 <u>later than midnight on the date the license expires</u>. All applications
- 15 for renewal of licenses that are personally presented to the department
- or sent by electronic means must be received by the department by 5:00
- 17 p.m. on the date the license expires. Each license shall be issued
