1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting institutions of higher education 2 from sharing students' personal information; and amending RCW 3 28B.10.042.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.042 and 2001 c 103 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

(1) Institutions of higher education shall not use the social
security number of any student, staff, or faculty for identification
except for the purposes of employment, financial aid, research,
assessment, accountability, transcripts, or as otherwise required by
state or federal law.

12 (2) Each institution of higher education shall develop a system of 13 personal identifiers for students to be used for grading and other 14 administrative purposes. The personal identifiers may not be social 15 security numbers.

16 (3) Personal identifiers and lists of currently enrolled students 17 shall not be shared, given, provided, or sold to organizations, 18 corporations, or other business entities, for the purpose of marketing

- 1 goods and services, by institutions of higher education and their
- 2 respective alumni associations, without written consent by the student.
