1            WHEREAS, Bills, joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent  
2 resolutions introduced at the 2003 regular and 1st special sessions of  
3 the Fifty-eighth Legislature may require that they be considered at the  
4 2003 second special session of the Fifty-eighth Legislature; and

5            WHEREAS, The public interest requires that the business of the 2003  
6 second special session of the Fifty-eighth Legislature be considered  
7 and acted upon as efficiently and expeditiously as possible;

8            NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of  
9 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That all bills,  
10 joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent resolutions  
11 introduced in the 2003 regular and 1st special sessions of the Fifty-  
12 eighth Legislature are reintroduced in the house in which they  
13 originated and shall retain the same number and be given the highest  
14 legislative status that they attained in the original house as shown by  
15 the official Senate and House dockets upon the adjournment SINE DIE of  
16 the 1st special session.
