AN ACT Relating to providing a death benefit for certain public employees; adding a new section to chapter 41.40 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.32 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.35 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 41.04 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.40 RCW 7 under the subchapter heading "provisions applicable to plan 1, plan 2, 8 and plan 3" to read as follows:

9 (1) A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid 10 the member's estate, or such person or persons, trust to or organization as the member has nominated by written designation duly 11 12 executed and filed with the department. If no such designated person or persons are still living at the time of the member's death, the 13 member's death benefit shall be paid to the member's surviving spouse 14 15 as if in fact the spouse had been nominated by written designation, or 16 there is no surviving spouse, then to the member's if legal 17 representatives.

1 (2) The benefit under this section shall be paid only where death 2 occurs as a result of injuries sustained in the course of employment. 3 The determination of eligibility for the benefit shall be made 4 consistent with Title 51 RCW by the department of labor and industries. 5 The department of labor and industries shall notify the department of 6 retirement systems by order under RCW 51.52.050.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 41.32 RCW under the subchapter heading "provisions applicable to plan 1, plan 2, and plan 3" to read as follows:

(1) A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid 10 to the member's estate, or such person or persons, trust or 11 organization as the member has nominated by written designation duly 12 executed and filed with the department. If no such designated person 13 or persons are still living at the time of the member's death, the 14 15 member's death benefit shall be paid to the member's surviving spouse 16 as if in fact the spouse had been nominated by written designation, or 17 if there is no surviving spouse, then to the member's legal 18 representatives.

(2) The benefit under this section shall be paid only where death occurs as a result of injuries sustained in the course of employment. The determination of eligibility for the benefit shall be made consistent with Title 51 RCW by the department of labor and industries. The department of labor and industries shall notify the department of retirement systems by order under RCW 51.52.050.

25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 41.35 RCW 26 under the subchapter heading "provisions applicable to plan 2 and plan 27 3" to read as follows:

(1) A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid 28 29 to the member's estate, or such person or persons, trust or 30 organization as the member has nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the department. If no such designated person 31 or persons are still living at the time of the member's death, the 32 member's death benefit shall be paid to the member's surviving spouse 33 34 as if in fact the spouse had been nominated by written designation, or 35 if there is no surviving spouse, then to the member's legal 36 representatives.

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1 (2) The benefit under this section shall be paid only where death 2 occurs as a result of injuries sustained in the course of employment. 3 The determination of eligibility for the benefit shall be made 4 consistent with Title 51 RCW by the department of labor and industries. 5 The department of labor and industries shall notify the department of 6 retirement systems by order under RCW 51.52.050.

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW 8 to read as follows:

9 A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid as a sundry claim to the estate of an employee of any state agency, the 10 common school system of the state, or institution of higher education 11 12 who dies as a result of injuries sustained in the course of employment and is not otherwise provided a death benefit through coverage under 13 their enrolled retirement system under this act. The determination of 14 eligibility for the benefit shall be made consistent with Title 51 RCW 15 16 by the department of labor and industries. The department of labor and industries shall notify the director of the department of general 17 administration by order under RCW 51.52.050. 18
