- AN ACT Relating to animal identification systems; and adding a new 1
- 2 section to chapter 16.57 RCW.

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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 16.57 RCW 4 5 to read as follows:
- (1) The director may adopt rules: 6
- 7 To support the agriculture industry in meeting federal 8 requirements for the country-of-origin labeling of meat. Any requirements established under this subsection for country of origin labeling purposes shall be substantially consistent with and shall not 10 exceed the requirements established by the United States department of 11 12 agriculture; and
- 13 (b) In consultation with the livestock identification advisory board under RCW 16.57.015, to implement federal requirements for animal 14 15 identification needed to trace the source of livestock for disease 16 control and response purposes.
- 17 (2) The director may cooperate with and enter into agreements with

- 1 other states and agencies of federal government to carry out such
- 2 systems and to promote consistency of regulation.
