1 AN ACT Relating to construction liability; and amending RCW 2 4.16.300.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 4.16.300 and 1986 c 305 s 703 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

RCW 4.16.300 through 4.16.320 shall apply to all claims or causes 6 7 of action of any kind against any person, arising from such person 8 having constructed, altered or repaired any improvement upon real 9 property, or having performed or furnished any design, planning, 10 surveying, architectural or construction or engineering services, or supervision or observation of construction, or administration of 11 construction contracts for any construction, alteration or repair of 12 13 any improvement upon real property. This section is specifically intended to benefit ((<del>only those persons referenced herein</del>)) persons 14 15 having performed work for which the persons must be registered or 16 licensed under RCW 18.08.310, 18.27.020, 18.43.040, 18.96.020, or 17 19.28.041, and shall not apply to claims or causes of action against ((manufacturers)) persons not required to be so registered or licensed. 18
