1            AN ACT Relating to the prohibition of sales of alcohol on  
2 university grounds; adding a new section to chapter 66.44 RCW; and  
3 repealing RCW 66.44.190.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.44.190 (Sales on university grounds  
6 prohibited--Exceptions) and 1999 c 281 s 10, 1997 c 321 s 62, 1979  
7 ex.s. c 104 s 1, 1975 1st ex.s. c 68 s 1, 1967 c 21 s 1, 1951 c 120 s  
8 1, 1933 ex.s. c 49 s 1, & 1895 c 75 s 1 are each repealed.

9            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 66.44 RCW  
10 to read as follows:

11            If an institution of higher education chooses to allow the sale of  
12 alcoholic beverages on campus, the legislature encourages the  
13 institution to feature products produced in the state of Washington.
