Brief Description: Allowing the use of body-gripping traps under certain circumstances.

HB 1968 - DIGEST

Declares that gopher and mole traps are not considered body-gripping traps.

Provides that, until July 1, 2008, nothing in this act prohibits the use of a number 110 Conibear trap to trap mountain beaver (*Aplodontia rufa*) on land by the owner or operator of commercial timber if nonlethal control tools, including but not limited to fencing, electric fencing, or tree-wrapping, cannot be reasonably applied.
