Sponsor(s): Representatives Schual-Berke, Benson, Cody, Carrell, Darneille and Boldt

Brief Description: Regarding fairness and accuracy in the distribution of risk in boarding homes and nursing homes.

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Finds that the inspection, reinspection, and complaint investigation procedures for licensed boarding homes must be strong, consistent, efficient, and fair.

Finds that the inspection, reinspection, and complaint facilitate open and investigation process should candid communication between licensors and providers and assure that violations are accurate and based on verified facts so unsubstantiated violations are eliminated.

Declares that those modifications will promote compliance with regulations by providers and achieve the goal of providing high quality of care to citizens residing in licensed boarding homes.

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
