Brief Description: Limiting tort liability of governmental entities.

HB 2881 - DIGEST

Provides that, in any action or claim filed against a governmental entity for damages arising out of its tortious conduct, or the intentional tortious conduct of its past or present public officials, whether acting in a governmental or proprietary capacity, no liability may be imposed against the governmental entity or the past or present public officials, unless the tortious conduct breached a duty owed to the injured person as an individual, rather than to the public in general.
