1 On page 3, line 1, after "(3)" strike all material through 2 "capacities," on line 3 and insert "Except as provided under 3 subsections (1), (2), and (4) of this section, judgments ((founded 4 on the tortious conduct of individuals or other entities, whether 5 acting in their personal or representative capacities,))"

6 On page 3, strike all material after "year." on line 24 and 7 insert "((Except as provided under subsections (1), (2), and (3) of 8 this section, judgments shall bear interest from the date of entry 9 at the maximum rate permitted under RCW 19.52.020 on the date of 10 entry thereof. In any case where a court is directed on review to enter judgment on a verdict or in any case where a judgment entered 11 on a verdict is wholly or partly affirmed on review, interest on 12 13 the judgment or on that portion of the judgment affirmed shall date 14 back to and shall accrue from the date the verdict was rendered. 15 The method for determining an interest rate prescribed by this 16 subsection is also the method for determining the "rate applicable 17 to civil judgments" for purposes of RCW 10.82.090.))"

EFFECT: Makes the interest rate on civil judgments T-bill plus two percentage points, the same rate as tort judgments under current law and legal financial obligations under the bill.
