3 On page 23, line 13, after "July 1," strike "2006" and insert  
4 "2007"

5 On page 40, beginning on line 27, after "November 15," strike all  
6 material through "council," on line 28, and insert "2007, the  
7 department of early learning"

8 On page 41, line 7, after "1," strike all material through  
9 "council" and insert "2008"

10 On page 42, beginning on line 7, strike all of section 604, and  
11 insert the following:

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 604.** The office of financial management shall  
13 develop a detailed plan for implementation of this act. The plan shall  
14 include a description of: Anticipated efficiency gains and costs  
15 savings; proposed agency organization, structure, and mission; proposed  
16 budget and staffing levels; historical client services offered;  
17 anticipated client services to be provided; and projected changes in  
18 service. The detailed implementation plan shall be submitted to the  
19 legislature by January 1, 2007.

20 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 605.** Sections 101 through 113, 201 through 212,  
21 301 through 315, 401 through 404, 501 through 506, and 601 of this act  
22 take effect July 1, 2007, if the legislature approves the plan in  
23 section 604 of this act either by concurrent resolution or by bill,  
24 during the 2007 legislative session. If the legislature does not

1 approve the plan in section 604 of this act by concurrent resolution or  
2 bill during the 2007 legislative session, this act is null and void."

3 Renumber the remaining section consecutively, correct any internal  
4 references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: Requires the Office of Financial Management to develop and submit to the legislature by January 1, 2007, a detailed implementation plan. Delays the effective date one year, and makes it contingent on legislative approval of the implementation plan. Legislative approval may be by concurrent resolution or legislation.
