EFFECT: Establishes that eligibility to participate in a sick leave pool is contingent on an employee using all sick, annual, and compensatory leave accrued to the employee, instead of being required to use only all sick leave accrued to the employee. Specifies that personnel authorities for higher education institutions are not required to adopt the sick leave pool rules enumerated in the act. Provides that personnel authorities of higher education institutions must adopt their own policies, consistent with the needs of the employees under their respective jurisdictions, to govern sick leave pools.
