1 On page 18, after line 38 of the amendment, insert:

2 "(6) The Department of Licensing, in consultation with the
3 Department of Transportation, Washington State Patrol, local law
4 enforcement agencies, and other appropriate organizations, shall
5 study the feasibility of creating a toll-free hotline for the
6 public to report violations of accessible parking laws, including
7 RCW 46.16.381 and 46.61.581. A report on the findings of this
8 study is due to the transportation committees of the legislature by
9 December 1, 2006, and shall include recommendations on how to
10 disseminate and publicize information to the public that explains
11 the existence, purpose, and method of accessing such a hotline, and
12 how to partner with appropriate law enforcement agencies in the
13 jurisdiction in which alleged violations occurred. In making
14 recommendations regarding the potential establishment of an
15 accessible parking violation hotline, the Department of Licensing
16 shall consider how to utilize or partner with existing statewide
17 and regional hotlines."

EFFECT: The Department of Licensing, in consultation with the Department of Transportation, Washington State Patrol, and local law enforcement agencies is required to study the feasibility of creating a toll-free hotline for the public to report violations of accessible parking laws.
