2 "Sec. 2. RCW 43.43.570 and 1987 c 450 s 1 are each amended to read

4 (1) No local law enforcement agency may establish or operate an
5 automatic fingerprint identification system unless(~~(+~~

7 use an interface compatible with the state system under RCW

9 ~~(b) The local system is equipped to receive and answer inquiries~~
10 ~~from the Washington state patrol automatic fingerprint identification~~
11 ~~system and transmit data to the Washington state patrol automatic~~
12 ~~fingerprint identification system)).~~ The local law enforcement agency
13 shall be able to transmit a tenprint record to the state system through
14 any available protocol which meets accepted industry standards, and the
15 state system must be able to accept tenprint records which comply with
16 those requirements. When industry transmission protocols change, the
17 Washington state patrol shall incorporate these new standards as
18 funding and reasonable system engineering practices permit. The
19 tenprint transmission from any local law enforcement agency must be in
20 accordance with the current version of the state electronic fingerprint
21 transmission specification.

22 (2) No later than January 1, 2007, the Washington state patrol's
23 automatic fingerprint identification system shall be capable of
24 instantly accepting electronic latent search records from any
25 Washington state local law enforcement agency. If specific funding for
26 the purposes of this subsection is not provided by June 30, 2006, in
27 the omnibus appropriations act, or if funding is not obtained from
28 another source by June 30, 2006, this subsection is null and void.

29 (3) A local law enforcement agency operating an automatic
30 fingerprint identification system shall transmit data on fingerprint

1 entries to the Washington state patrol electronically ((by computer)).
2 This requirement shall be in addition to those under RCW 10.98.050 and
3 43.43.740.

4 ~~((3) Counties or local agencies that purchased or signed a
5 contract to purchase an automatic fingerprint identification system
6 prior to January 1, 1987, are exempt from the requirements of this
7 section. The Washington state patrol shall charge fees for processing
8 latent fingerprints submitted to the patrol by counties or local
9 jurisdictions exempted from the requirements of this section. The fees
10 shall cover, as nearly as practicable, the direct and indirect costs to
11 the patrol of processing such fingerprints.))~~

12 (4) Any personnel functions necessary to prepare fingerprints for
13 searches under this section shall be the responsibility of the
14 submitting agency.

15 (5) The Washington state patrol shall adopt rules to implement this
16 section."
