# **HB 1711**

**Brief Description:** Revising marking requirement parking places for persons with disabilities.

**Sponsors:** Representatives Wallace, Woods, Simpson, Morrell, Lovick, Flannigan, Chase, Moeller and Kilmer.

## **Brief Summary of Bill**

• Deletes requirement that parking spaces for persons with a disabilities include the notice "State disabled parking permit required."

**Hearing Date:** 2/21/05

#### **Background:**

To be enforceable, parking spaces for persons with disabilities are required to have two indicators. The first is a sign with the international symbol of access. The second is a notice which states that a "State disabled parking permit required."

### **Summary of Bill:**

The requirement that parking spaces for persons with disabilities are marked by a notice stating that a disabled parking permit is required is deleted.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Effective Date:** The bill takes effect 90 days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
