- AN ACT Relating to Clark College license plates; amending RCW 1
- 2 46.16.290; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313 and 46.16.316; and
- 3 adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 6
- to read as follows:
- 7 The department, the Washington state patrol, and Clark College
- 8 shall work cooperatively to create and design a special Clark College
- license plate. The special Clark College license plate may be used in 9
- 10 lieu of regular or personalized license plates for motor vehicles
- required to display two motor vehicle license plates, excluding 11
- 12 vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions
- established by the department. 13
- 14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
- to read as follows: 15
- The Clark College license plate account is created in the state 16
- 17 treasury. All receipts from the Clark College license plate fees, less
- 18 the administration and collection costs incurred by the department as

provided for under RCW 46.16.313 (12) and (13), must be deposited into 1 the account. Expenditures from the account should be used primarily 2 for student scholarships but may also be used for advertising and 3

- promotional activities designed to increase the sale of the Clark
- College license plate. All expenditures from this account must be 5
- approved by the Clark College foundation scholarship committee. Moneys 6
- 7 in the account may only be spent after appropriation.

- Sec. 3. RCW 46.16.313 and 2004 c 221 s 3, 2004 c 48 s 3, and 2004 8 c 35 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows: 9
- (1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 10 11 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 12 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the 13 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration 14 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to 15 16 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 17 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to 18 the motor vehicle fund. 19
 - (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.
 - (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state

HB 1006 p. 2 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

- (4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund.
- (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund.
- (6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been

reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

- (7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.
- (8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.
- 37 (9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November 38 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon

Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law enforcement memorial account memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

(11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until

- (12) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special Clark College license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty-five dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The department shall remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the Clark College license plate account under section 2 of this act.
- (13) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special Clark College license plate shall pay a fee of thirty-five dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The department shall remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the Clark College license plate account under section 2 of this act.
- **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.16.290 and 2004 c 223 s 3 are each amended to read 29 as follows:
 - (1) In any case of a valid sale or transfer of the ownership of any vehicle, the right to the certificates ((properly transferable therewith, except as provided in RCW 46.16.280,)) and to the vehicle license plates, except as provided in RCW 46.16.316, passes to the purchaser or transferee. It is unlawful for the holder of such certificates, except as provided in RCW 46.16.280, or vehicle license plates, except as provided in RCW 46.16.316, to fail, neglect, or

refuse to endorse the certificates and deliver the vehicle license plates to the purchaser or transferee.

- (2)(a) If the sale or transfer is of a vehicle licensed with current standard issue license plates, the vehicle license plates may be retained and displayed upon a vehicle obtained in replacement of the vehicle so sold or transferred. If a person applies for a transfer of the plate or plates to another eligible vehicle, the plates must be transferred to a vehicle requiring the same type of plate. A transfer fee of ten dollars must be charged in addition to all other applicable fees. The transfer fees must be deposited in the motor vehicle fund.
- (b) If the sale or transfer is of a vehicle licensed by the state or any county, city, town, school district, or other political subdivision entitled to exemption as provided by law, or, if the vehicle is licensed with personalized plates, amateur radio operator plates, medal of honor plates, disabled person plates, disabled veteran plates, prisoner of war plates, or other special license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301 or 46.16.313 as now existing or as it existed before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, the vehicle license plates therefor ((shall)) may be transferred as provided in RCW 46.16.316, in which case they may be retained and ((may be)) displayed upon a vehicle obtained in replacement of the vehicle so sold or transferred.
- **Sec. 5.** RCW 46.16.316 and 2004 c 223 s 4, 2004 c 221 s 5, 2004 c 24 48 s 5, and 2004 c 35 s 5 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

Except as provided in RCW 46.16.305:

(1) When a person who has been issued a special license plate or plates: (a) Under RCW 46.16.30901, 46.16.30903, 46.16.30905, ((ex)) 46.16.301, or 46.16.313 as now existing or as it existed before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, or under RCW 46.16.305(2) or 46.16.324; or (b) approved by the special license plate review board under RCW 46.16.715 through 46.16.775 sells, trades, or otherwise transfers or releases ownership of the vehicle upon which the special license plate or plates have been displayed, he or she shall immediately report the transfer of such plate or plates to an acquired vehicle or vehicle eligible for such plates pursuant to departmental rule, or he or she shall surrender such plates to the department

immediately if such surrender is required by departmental rule. If a person applies for a transfer of the plate or plates to another eligible vehicle, a transfer fee of ten dollars shall be charged in addition to all other applicable fees. Such transfer fees shall be deposited in the motor vehicle fund. Failure to surrender the plates when required is a traffic infraction.

(2) If the special license plate or plates issued by the department become lost, defaced, damaged, or destroyed, application for a replacement special license plate or plates shall be made and fees paid as provided by law for the replacement of regular license plates.
