- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.64.020 and 1989 c 367 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
 - The commission shall consist of eleven members. One member shall be a judge selected by and from the court of appeals judges; one member shall be a judge selected by and from the superior court judges; one member shall be a judge selected by and from the ((district)) limited jurisdiction court judges; two members shall be selected by the state bar association and be admitted to the practice of law in this state; and six members shall be nonlawyers appointed by the governor. The term of each member of the commission shall be four years.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act takes effect January 1, 2006, if the proposed amendment to Article IV, section 31 of the state Constitution (House Joint Resolution No. . . , changing the membership of the commission on judicial conduct) is validly submitted to and is
