1 AN ACT Relating to disbursement of liquor revolving fund moneys for
2 the purpose of funding alcohol education programs; and amending RCW
3 66.08.180.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.08.180 and 2000 c 192 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 Except as provided in RCW 66.24.290(1), moneys in the liquor
8 revolving fund shall be distributed by the board at least once every
9 three months in accordance with RCW 66.08.190, 66.08.200 and 66.08.210:
10 PROVIDED, That the board shall reserve from distribution such amount
11 not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars as may be necessary for the
12 proper administration of this title.

13 (1) All license fees, penalties and forfeitures derived under
14 chapter 13, Laws of 1935 from spirits, beer, and wine restaurant;
15 spirits, beer, and wine private club; and sports entertainment facility
16 licenses or spirits, beer, and wine restaurant; spirits, beer, and wine
17 private club; and sports entertainment facility licensees shall every
18 three months be disbursed by the board as follows:

1 (a) Three hundred thousand dollars per biennium, to the death
2 investigations account for the state toxicology program pursuant to RCW
3 68.50.107; and

4 (b) Of the remaining funds:

5 (i) 6.06 percent to the University of Washington and 4.04 percent
6 to Washington State University for alcoholism and drug abuse research
7 and for the dissemination of such research; and

8 (ii) 89.9 percent to the general fund to be used by the department
9 of social and health services solely to carry out the purposes of RCW
10 70.96A.050;

11 (2) (~~The first fifty five~~) One hundred fifty thousand dollars
12 (~~per~~) annually from the license fees provided in RCW 66.24.320 and
13 66.24.330 (~~up to a maximum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars~~
14 ~~annually~~) shall be (~~disbursed every three months by the board to the~~
15 ~~general fund to be used for juvenile alcohol and drug prevention~~
16 ~~programs for kindergarten through third grade to be administered by the~~
17 ~~superintendent of public instruction~~) used by the board to fund its
18 alcohol education program authorized by RCW 66.08.050;

19 (3) Twenty percent of the remaining total amount derived from
20 license fees pursuant to RCW 66.24.320, 66.24.330, 66.24.350, and
21 66.24.360, shall be transferred to the general fund to be used by the
22 department of social and health services solely to carry out the
23 purposes of RCW 70.96A.050; and

24 (4) One-fourth cent per liter of the tax imposed by RCW 66.24.210
25 shall every three months be disbursed by the board to Washington State
26 University solely for wine and wine grape research, extension programs
27 related to wine and wine grape research, and resident instruction in
28 both wine grape production and the processing aspects of the wine
29 industry in accordance with RCW 28B.30.068. The director of financial
30 management shall prescribe suitable accounting procedures to ensure
31 that the funds transferred to the general fund to be used by the
32 department of social and health services and appropriated are
33 separately accounted for.

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
