- MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.15 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) It is unlawful for any private citizen or public employee to release from captivity anywhere in the state a barred owl (Strix varia) or a barred owl/spotted owl hybrid (Strix occidentalis x Strix varia) that has been captured alive pursuant to the authority granted in a
- 10 federal permit.
- 11 (2) A violation of this section shall be punished as a natural 12 resource infraction under chapter 7.84 RCW.
