AN ACT Relating to creating a hearsay exception for statements offered against a party that has engaged or acquiesced in wrongdoing; and adding a new chapter to Title 5 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A statement shall not be excluded by the 6 rules of evidence applicable to hearsay if: (1) The declarant is 7 unavailable as a witness; and (2) the statement is being offered 8 against a party that has engaged or acquiesced in wrongdoing that was 9 intended to, and did, procure the unavailability of the declarant as a 10 witness.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Section 1 of this act constitutes a new 12 chapter in Title 5 RCW.
