- AN ACT Relating to the use of day-time running lights at night; and amending RCW 46.37.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.37.020 and 1977 ex.s. c 355 s 2 are each amended to read as follows:
 - (1) Every vehicle upon a highway within this state at any time from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise and at any other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet ahead shall display lighted head lights, other lights, and illuminating devices as hereinafter respectively required for different classes of vehicles,
- subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles, and such stop
- 14 lights, turn signals, and other signaling devices shall be lighted as
- 15 prescribed for the use of such devices.
