1 AN ACT Relating to providing a mechanism for counties to 2 participate in the cougar control pilot project created by the 2004 3 legislature; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A county legislative authority may request 6 inclusion in the cougar control pilot project authorized by chapter 7 264, Laws of 2004 after taking the following actions:

8 (1) Adopting a resolution that requests inclusion in the pilot 9 project;

10 (2) Documenting the need to participate in the pilot project by 11 identifying the number of cougar/human encounters and livestock and pet 12 depredations; and

(3) Demonstrating that existing cougar depredation permits, public
safety cougar hunts, or other existing wildlife management tools have
not been sufficient to deal with cougar incidents in the county.
