AN ACT Relating to a program to develop proposed legislation that provides business and occupation tax credits to physicians serving uninsured, medicare, and medicaid patients; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The department of health shall develop, in 6 consultation with the department of revenue, a program to provide 7 business and occupation tax credits for physicians who serve uninsured, 8 medicare, and medicaid patients in a private practice or a reduced fee 9 access program for the uninsured and shall submit proposed legislation 10 to the legislature by December 15, 2005.
