- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28B.15 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) The legislature finds that when members of the Washington national guard are called into overseas active duty, their absence 9 10 poses a hardship on their families in many ways. Frequently their compensation is reduced from its normal levels, making financial 11 obligations more difficult to meet. Therefore, the legislature intends 12 to support national guard members by waiving their children's tuition 13 14 charges while they are on overseas active duty.
- 15 (2) Subject to the limitations of RCW 28B.15.910, the governing 16 boards of the state universities, the regional universities, Evergreen State College, and the community colleges may waive all or a 17 portion of tuition and fees for students who: 18

- 1 (a) Are dependent children of members of the Washington national 2 guard who have been ordered into federal active military service for a 3 period exceeding thirty days to serve in a war or conflict fought on 4 foreign soil; and
 - (b) Qualify as a resident student under RCW 28B.15.012, except RCW 28B.15.012(2)(g).
 - (3) If a governing board exercises the authority under this section, the board shall also adopt policies that provide a full or partial refund of tuition already paid for a quarter or semester during which a student becomes eligible for the waiver under this section.
- 11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.15.910 and 2004 c 275 s 51 are each amended to 12 read as follows:
 - (1) For the purpose of providing state general fund support to public institutions of higher education, except for revenue waived under programs listed in subsections (3) and (4) of this section, and unless otherwise expressly provided in the omnibus state appropriations act, the total amount of operating fees revenue waived, exempted, or reduced by a state university, a regional university, The Evergreen State College, or the community colleges as a whole, shall not exceed the percentage of total gross authorized operating fees revenue in this subsection. As used in this section, "gross authorized operating fees revenue as estimated under RCW 82.33.020 or as revised by the office of financial management, before granting any waivers. This limitation applies to all tuition waiver programs established before or after July 1, 1992.
- 26 (a) University of Washington 21 percent 27 (b) Washington State University 20 percent (c) Eastern Washington University 28 11 percent (d) Central Washington University 29 8 percent 30 (e) Western Washington University 10 percent 31 (f) The Evergreen State College 6 percent (g) Community colleges as a whole 32 35 percent

- (4) The total amount of operating fees revenue waived, exempted, or 30 31 reduced by institutions of higher education participating in the 32 western interstate commission for higher education western undergraduate exchange program under RCW 28B.15.544 shall not exceed 33 the percentage of total gross authorized operating fees revenue in this 34 35 subsection.
