- 6 Unless the context requires otherwise, the definitions in this 7 section apply throughout this chapter.
- 8 (1) "Long-term care insurance" or "long-term care benefit contract" 9 means any insurance policy or benefit contract primarily advertised,
- 10 marketed, offered, or designed to provide coverage or services for
- 11 either institutional or community-based convalescent, custodial,
- 12 chronic, or terminally ill care. <u>Such terms include adult family</u>
- 13 <u>homes, boarding homes, and assisted living facilities.</u> Such terms do
- 14 not include and this chapter shall not apply to policies or contracts
- 15 governed by chapter 48.66 RCW and continuing care retirement
- 16 communities.
- 17 (2) "Loss ratio" means the incurred claims plus or minus the
- 18 increase or decrease in reserves as a percentage of the earned

premiums, or the projected incurred claims plus or minus the increase or decrease in projected reserves as a percentage of projected earned premiums, as defined by the commissioner.

- (3) "Preexisting condition" means a covered person's medical condition that caused that person to have received medical advice or treatment during the specified time period before the effective date of coverage.
- 8 (4) "Medicare" means Title XVIII of the United States social 9 security act, or its successor program.
- 10 (5) "Medicaid" means Title XIX of the United States social security 11 act, or its successor program.
- 12 (6) "Nursing home" means a nursing home as defined in RCW 13 18.51.010.
