- 8 is appropriated for fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, from the state
- 9 public safety and education account to the department of labor and
- 10 industries for the additional costs incurred by the department in the
- 11 crime victims compensation program.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to 2003 1st sp.s. c
- 13 25 (uncodified) to read as follows:
- 14 The sum of three million six hundred twenty-seven thousand dollars
- 15 is appropriated for fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, from the state
- 16 general fund to the state public safety and education account for the
- 17 additional costs incurred by the department of labor and industries in
- 18 the crime victims compensation program.
