- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 19.16 RCW to read as follows:
- No person, other than an entity subject to RCW 19.16.500, may assign a debt to a collection agency unless:
 - (1) The person has made an attempt to advise the debtor (a) of the existence of the debt; and (b) that the debt may be assigned to a collection agency for collection if the debt is not paid within ten days after the date of notice of the existence of the debt; and
- 12 (2) At least thirty days have elapsed from the time notice was 13 attempted.
