The legislature finds that the social and 4 5 economic costs that substance abuse inflicts on individuals, families, and communities in the state of Washington is devastating. 6 7 legislature further finds that effective substance abuse reduction 8 requires prevention efforts and chemical dependency treatment to help reduce the progressive disease that leads to behavioral problems and 10 increased costs in the state's criminal justice system.
