1 AN ACT Relating to geoduck harvesting; amending RCW 77.65.410; and 2 declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4	Sec. 1. RCW 77.65.410 and 1993 c 340 s 24 are each amended to read
5	as follows:
6	(1) Licensed geoduck harvesters bear the responsibility for
7	providing the labor and equipment to plant geoduck seed provided by a
8	state hatchery onto state commercial beds.
9	(2) Every diver engaged in the commercial harvest of geoduck clams
10	shall obtain a ((nontransferable)) <u>transferable</u> geoduck diver license.
11	(3) After July 1, 2005, the director may not issue new geoduck
12	diver licenses unless fewer than fifty persons are eligible for
13	renewal. A person may renew an existing license only if the person:
14	(a) Held a geoduck diver license in 2004; and
15	(i) Held a geoduck diver license in 2001 and 2002; or
16	(ii) Held a geoduck diver license for five of the ten years from
17	<u>1994 through 2003; and</u>
18	(b)(i) Can document active diving participation by way of dive

(ii) Acquired the license by transfer from another person who held
it during the previous year, and the person did not subsequently
transfer the license to a third party.

4 <u>(4) If fewer than fifty persons are eligible to renew a geoduck</u> 5 diver license, the director may accept applications for new licenses. 6 The department shall adopt rules and procedures to determine whether 7 additional diver licenses will be issued, and the application 8 procedure. The director shall determine, by random selection, from all 9 otherwise qualified applicants, the successful applicants for any 10 additional licenses.

11 (5) When a person fails to obtain a license during the previous 12 year because of a license suspension, a person may qualify for a 13 license by establishing that he or she held such a license during the 14 last year in which the license was not suspended.

(6) Geoduck diver licenses are transferable only to a natural
person. The license holder must perform the actual harvesting.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 18 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 19 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 20 immediately.
