- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 29A.08.230 and 2003 c 111 s 218 are each amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 For all voter registrations, the registrant shall sign the
- 7 following oath:
- 8 "I declare that the facts on this voter registration form are true.
- 9 I am a citizen of the United States, I am not presently denied my civil
- 10 rights as a result of being convicted of a felony, I will have lived in
- 11 Washington at this address for thirty days immediately before the next
- 12 election at which I vote, and I will be at least ((eighteen)) sixteen
- 13 years old when I vote."
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect if the proposed
- 15 amendment to Article VI, section 1 of the state Constitution allowing
- 16 persons who are sixteen years of age or older to vote is validly

- 2 general election. If the proposed amendment is not approved and
- 3 ratified, this act is void in its entirety.
