- AN ACT Relating to limiting the phosphorus content in dishwashing
- detergent; and amending RCW 70.95L.005 and 70.95L.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.95L.005 and 1993 c 118 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The legislature hereby finds and declares that:
- 7 (1) Phosphorus loading of surface waters can stimulate the growth 8 of weeds and algae, and that such growth can have adverse 9 environmental, health, and aesthetic effects;
 - (2) Household detergents contribute to phosphorus loading, and that a limit on detergents containing phosphorus can significantly reduce the discharge of phosphorus into the state's surface and ground waters;
- (3) Household detergents containing no or very low phosphorus are readily available and that over thirty percent of the United States population lives in areas with a ban on detergents containing phosphorus; ((and))
- 17 (4) Phosphorus limits on household detergents can significantly 18 reduce treatment costs at those sewage treatment facilities that remove 19 phosphorus from the waste stream; and

- 1 (5) While significant reductions of phosphorus from laundry
 2 detergent have been accomplished, similar progress in reducing
 3 phosphorus contributions from dishwashing detergents has not been
 4 achieved.
- It is therefore the intent of the legislature to impose a statewide limit on the phosphorus content of household detergents.
- 7 **Sec. 2.** RCW 70.95L.020 and 1993 c 118 s 3 are each amended to read 8 as follows:
- 9 (1) After July 1, 1994, a person may not sell or distribute for 10 sale a laundry detergent that contains 0.5 percent or more phosphorus 11 by weight.
- 12 (2) After July 1, ((1994)) 2007, a person may not sell or distribute for sale a dishwashing detergent that contains ((8.7)) 0.5 percent or more phosphorous by weight.
- 15 (3) This section does not apply to the sale or distribution of 16 detergents for commercial and industrial uses.
