1            AN ACT Relating to offshore items; and adding a new chapter to  
2 Title 39 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** The definitions in this section apply  
5 throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

6            (1) "State" means the state of Washington and all departments,  
7 supervisors, commissioners, and agencies thereof.

8            (2) "Municipality" means every city, county, town, district, or  
9 other public agency thereof that is authorized by law to require the  
10 execution of public work.

11           (3) "Contract" means a contract in writing for the execution of  
12 public work for a fixed or determinable amount and a contract for the  
13 purchase of materials, supplies, goods, wares, or merchandise duly  
14 awarded after advertisement and competitive bid.

15           (4) "Offshore items" means those items procured from sources beyond  
16 the territorial boundaries of the United States including Alaska and  
17 Hawaii.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**    When competitive bids are solicited for  
2 public contract, the solicitation shall set forth, in addition to the  
3 terms and specifications thereof, a requirement that the bidder shall  
4 furnish, upon completion of the contract, a statement certified by the  
5 bidder setting forth the nature and source of offshore items in excess  
6 of two thousand five hundred dollars that have been used in the  
7 performance of the contract.

8        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    The director of general administration,  
9 through the division of purchasing, regarding all contracts to which  
10 the state is a party, and the responsible purchasing officers of each  
11 municipality, regarding all contracts to which the municipality is a  
12 party, shall keep the certificates required by section 2 of this act  
13 and shall maintain them in an orderly fashion. The certificates shall  
14 be available for examination by the public. They shall be kept for a  
15 period of five years from the date of their receipt.

16        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 4.**    This act applies to solicitations issued on  
17 or after July 1, 2006.

18        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 5.**    Sections 1 through 4 of this act constitute  
19 a new chapter in Title 39 RCW.
