1 AN ACT Relating to the enhanced 911 advisory committee; and 2 amending RCW 38.52.530.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 38.52.530 and 2002 c 341 s 3 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

The enhanced 911 advisory committee is created to advise and assist 6 7 the state enhanced 911 coordinator in coordinating and facilitating the 8 implementation and operation of enhanced 911 throughout the state. The 9 director shall appoint members of the committee who represent diverse geographical areas of the state and include state residents who are 10 members of the national emergency number association, the associated 11 12 public communications officers Washington chapter, the Washington state 13 fire chiefs association, the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs, the Washington state council of fire fighters, the 14 15 Washington state council of police officers, the Washington ambulance association, the state fire protection policy board, the Washington 16 17 fire commissioners association, the Washington state patrol, the 18 association of Washington cities, the Washington state association of 19 counties, the utilities and transportation commission or commission

staff, and an equal number of representatives of large and small local exchange telephone companies and large and small radio communications service companies offering commercial mobile radio service in the state. ((This section expires December 31, 2006.))
