(1) Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitionsin this subsection apply to this section only.

(a) "Sex offender treatment provider" or "treatment provider" means
a certified sex offender treatment provider or a certified affiliate
sex offender treatment provider as defined in RCW 18.155.020.

30 (b) "Substantial bodily harm" means bodily injury that involves a 31 temporary but substantial disfigurement, or that causes a temporary but 32 substantial loss or impairment of the function of any body part or 33 organ, or that causes a fracture of any body part or organ.

34 (c) "Victim" means any person who has sustained emotional,35 psychological, physical, or financial injury to person or property as

35 (v) Other evaluation measures used.

(b) The examiner shall assess and report regarding the offender's 1 2 amenability to treatment and relative risk to the community. Α proposed treatment plan shall be provided and shall include, at a 3 minimum: 4

(i) Frequency and type of contact between offender and therapist; 5

(ii) Specific issues to be addressed in the treatment and 6 7 description of planned treatment modalities;

(iii) Monitoring plans, including any requirements regarding living 8 conditions, lifestyle requirements, and monitoring by family members 9 and others; 10

(iv) Anticipated length of treatment; and

(v) Recommended crime-related prohibitions and affirmative 12 13 conditions, which must include, to the extent known, an identification 14 specific activities or behaviors that are precursors to the of offender's offense cycle, including, but not limited to, activities or 15 behaviors such as viewing or listening to pornography or use of alcohol 16 17 or controlled substances.

(c) The court on its own motion may order, or on a motion by the 18 state shall order, a second examination regarding the offender's 19 amenability to treatment. The examiner shall be selected by the party 20 21 making the motion. The offender shall pay the cost of any second 22 examination ordered unless the court finds the defendant to be indigent 23 in which case the state shall pay the cost.

24 (4) After receipt of the reports, the court shall consider whether 25 the offender and the community will benefit from use of this alternative, consider whether the alternative is too lenient in light 26 27 of the extent and circumstances of the offense, consider whether the offender has victims in addition to the victim of the offense, consider 28 whether the offender is amenable to treatment, consider the risk the 29 offender would present to the community, to the victim, or to persons 30 31 of similar age and circumstances as the victim, and consider the 32 victim's opinion whether the offender should receive a treatment disposition under this section. The court shall give great weight to 33 the victim's opinion whether the offender should receive a treatment 34 disposition under this section. If the sentence imposed is contrary to 35 the victim's opinion, the court shall enter written findings stating 36 37 its reasons for imposing the treatment disposition. amenability to treatment. If the court determines that this alternative is appropriate, the court shall then impose a sentence or, pursuant to RCW 9.94A.712, a minimum term of sentence, within the standard sentence range. If the sentence imposed is less than eleven years of confinement, the court may suspend the execution of the sentence and impose the following conditions of suspension:

7 (a) The court shall order the offender to serve a term of confinement of up to twelve months or the maximum term within the 8 standard range, whichever is less. (b) If a second violation of the prohibitions or affirmative conditions relating to precursor behaviors or activities imposed under subsection (4)(d) or (7)(b) of this section occurs during community custody, the department shall refer the violation to the court and recommend revocation of the suspended sentence as provided in subsection (10) of this section.

(10) The court may revoke the suspended sentence at any time during the period of community custody and order execution of the sentence if: (a) The offender violates the conditions of the suspended sentence, or (b) the court finds that the offender is failing to make satisfactory progress in treatment. All confinement time served during the period of community custody shall be credited to the offender if the suspended sentence is revoked.

(11) The offender's sex offender treatment provider may not be the 1 2 same person who examined the offender under subsection (3) of this section or any person who employs, is employed by, or shares profits 3 with the person who examined the offender under subsection (3) of this 4 section, unless the court has entered written findings that such 5 treatment is in the best interests of the victim and that successful б 7 treatment of the offender would otherwise be impractical.
